

## HOW TO REACH US

June 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>

### DIPARTIMENTO DI SCIENZE ECONOMICHE E AZIENDALI UNIVERSITÀ DI PARMA

Via Kennedy John Fitzgerald, 6 – Parma

The Department is easily accessible by major transportation means. It is approximately 1.5 km from the train station, about 6 km from the highway exit, and around 4.5 km from the airport.

#### BY CAR

Paid parking spaces are available at the Department in the [underground parking](#) lot (Parking Kennedy, Parma) and [on-street](#) in the blue lines ([click on the links to get directions via Google Maps](#)).

#### BY TRAIN

The Parma train station is located along the Milan – Bologna – Rome route.

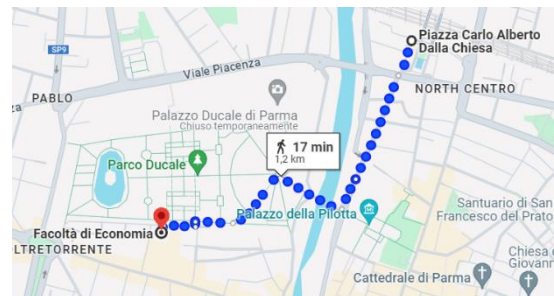
#### BY BUS

At the Parma train station, on level -2, you can take **TEP bus No. 7** towards "Università"; alternatively, from Viale Bottego, in front of the train station, you can take **TEP bus No. 23** towards "San Secondo". In both cases, get off at the "Barriera Santa Croce" stop and, in a few minutes, you can walk to the Department along Via Kennedy John Fitzgerald.

#### ON FOOT

From the Parma train station, the Department is about a 17-minute walk; on the way you will have a chance to pass by Parco Ducale, one of the city's parks. The [recommended route](#) from the train station is:



#### AIRPORT

Parma Airport is connected to the city center and the train station by **TEP bus No. 6**. The stop is located a few meters from the airport entrance, and a ride is guaranteed every 30 minutes.

#### BY TAXI

The taxi ride from the train station to the Department takes about 10 minutes.

## **CRÉDIT AGRICOLE GREEN LIFE**

Via La Spezia 138/A – Parma

The Crédit Agricole headquarters are easily accessible by major transportation means. The reception desk for access to the facility is at the Green Life porter's lodge.

### **BY CAR**

Green Life is about a 15-minute drive from the **"Parma" exit on the A1 highway**. Take the Tangenziale Ovest and continue to exit 12 - Via La Spezia.
